

Division of Global Learning and Partnerships Alpha Epsilon Lambda Scholarship 2016-17 Application & Instructions

The AEL Scholarship is coordinated by the current AEL President and candidates are selected by a majority vote of the AEL Scholarship Committee. A scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 will be awarded each academic year based upon academic qualification and responses to the writing prompts. Please note that former scholarship recipients are ineligible to apply again.

AEL Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, by the application deadline, you must:

- Be a currently matriculated student in a graduate-level academic program at Rowan University in good standing
- Be currently registered for coursework in the upcoming semester
- Be an active member of Rowan's Upsilon chapter of Alpha Epsilon Lambda
- Submit a complete AEL Scholarship Application as outlined within this document
- Agree that, if awarded the AEL Scholarship, you will serve on the Scholarship Committee for one (1) year following the award date to help select the next recipient

How to Apply

After ensuring that you meet the eligibility requirements, please submit a complete Scholarship Application Packet which consists of the following:

- 1. Scholarship Application Form (included in this document)
- 2. Statement of approximately 500 words describing why you are a deserving candidate for the scholarship. Responses should address the following:
 - Describe your current commitment to service and/or leadership in your community.
 - Provide examples of any service or leadership contributions you have made to Rowan University during your time as a graduate student.

AEL Spring 2017 Scholarship Application Deadline:

- Friday, November 4, 2016
- Scholarship recipient will be notified in early November and formally recognized at the Fall 2016 AEL meeting on November 21, 2016
